

## **Publication of list of individuals and entities under the United Nations Sanctions (Libya) Regulation 2019 on CEDB's website**

On **20 December 2024 (New York Time)**, the Security Council of the United Nations (“UNSC”) announced that the UNSC Committee established pursuant to UNSC Resolution 1970 concerning Libya **removed one individual** from its sanctions list. Please refer to the [press release](#) for details.

Pursuant to section 43 of the United Nations Sanctions (Libya) Regulation 2019 (Cap. 537CF) (“Libya Regulation”), an updated list of individuals and entities was published on [CEDB’s website](#) today. Section 9 of the Libya Regulation prohibits the making available of economic assets to or for the benefit of persons and entities on the list; as well as dealing with any economic assets belonging to, or owned or controlled by such persons or entities.
